> US - EQUINE HERPESVIRUS A new outbreak of the neurological form of equine herpesvirus (EHV-1) has been confirmed by California veterinary authorities. A total of nine cases have been confirmed at a single location since January 11, 2012. The source of the outbreak has yet to be identified, but the initial investigation reveals no link to three outbreaks in 2011. (*DVM360*)
